



## Travelling to Wollongong by Train

North Wollongong Station is the closest to the Wollongong Campus, on the South Coast line. By train it takes about 90 minutes from/to Sydney Central. See the [South Coast Line timetables](#).

## Walk or catch the Free North Gong Shuttle Bus

It's about a 20 min walk from the North Gong station to Wollongong Campus or a quick ride on the [free NG shuttle bus](#), which is scheduled to meet with most trains. Please note that a reduced service will be operating for the duration of the workshop as it is outside UOW teaching sessions.



## Paying a fare - using opal cards

While the UOW Shuttle Buses and the NSW Government Gong Shuttle are free of charge. If you are catching a regular bus or train service, you need to pay a fare using an Opal Card. Opal Cards are smart card tickets that you load money onto and use for public transport across NSW.
